The Aggie Catholic Ambassadors is a group of students attending either Texas A&M University or Blinn College who are leaders at both St. Mary's Catholic Center and on campus in the classroom. The ambassadors serve as the student face of our ministry – showing donors and the community the fruits of St. Mary's. Being an ambassador builds leadership skills and each student is fundamental in shaping programs here at St. Mary's Catholic Center. The Aggie Catholic Ambassadors will meet with St. Mary's Catholic Center's top donors – giving students opportunities to network with people around the state and country.

## **Aggie Catholic Ambassador responsibilities (including, but not limited to):**

- **Host donor appreciation weekend**
  - St. Mary's Catholic Center is very blessed to know many donors who have incredible leadership skills, live out their Catholic faith, and love the Aggie Catholics. The Ambassadors will plan, promote, and host a weekend with St. Mary's donors at least once during the year. This will help donors become more engaged with the students at St. Mary's and will help students learn from the experiences and wisdom of donors.
- **Serve as the voice of the student population**
  - St. Mary's Catholic Center is growing and in that growth it is essential for the students to have ambassadors voice their needs or concerns. The staff of St. Mary's may call upon the ambassadors for advice or guidance as we work to provide this great ministry.
- **Communicate with St. Mary's donors**
  - Every single one of St. Mary's donors would love to hear from the students. The Ambassadors will communicate with our benefactors in various different ways whether it is through email, phone conversations or handwritten letters.
- **Meeting with donors at events and possible appointments with gift officers**
  - Ambassadors serve as the face of our students and therefore are a huge part of reaching out to our donors. Ambassadors will meet donors at events and any other opportunities that come up during the year; reaching out to St. Mary's donors, learning their stories and sharing their own.
- **Attendance at Leadership Symposium and Ambassador Meetings**
  - St. Mary's Catholic Center hosts a Leadership Symposium for our students; teaching them about how to be effective leaders in real life and organizations. This is planned for a weekend before school starts in the Fall Semester.
  - As a way to learn more about the inner workings of St. Mary's and bond together as a group there will be an Ambassador Orientation Day in the fall each year. There will also be other socials and meetings within the group so the Ambassadors can be effective leaders.
